The managing editor of MT Proceedings will be principally responsible for the review of all conference proposals received by the journal, with input from the publisher as needed. Alongside this main responsibility, they will also be required to collaborate with a range of stakeholders across Elsevier and externally with the following activities:

- Support the publisher, journal manager, content specialist and conferences team in the development of the journal's policies and workflows
- Collaborate with web management teams and publishing support offices on website updates and development
- Collaborate with the publisher in the development of guest editor training materials and resources
- Work with the journal manager to support guest editors and authors during the publication process
- Work with the publisher and ethics team to handle ethical issues that arise
- Collaborate with the publisher on university outreach efforts

- Support in the development and management of the external editorial board
- Act as a champion of MT Proceedings
